



GRAND LAC VICTORIA

DESCRIPTION

The Grand Lac Victoria Settlement occupies an undivided part of the township of Hamon.

It covers approximately 12 hectares.

LOCATION

The settlement is located where the Ottawa river flows into Great Lake Victoria, 60 kilometres south of Val d'Or.

LAND TITLE HISTORY

Grand Lac Victoria Settlement does not have the Indian reserve status. The territory has been occupied since long ago by the Indians, who view it as an ancestral meeting place.

CHRONOLOGY OF BOUNDARY SURVEYS

The settlement boundaries have never been defined. It is certain, however, that its occupation by the Indians dates back a very long time.
