



WINNEWAY

DESCRIPTION

The Winneway Settlement consists of:

- lots 50 (part) and 51 (part) of Range 8;
 - lot 46 of Range 9, in the township of Devlin.

It covers an area of 36.8 hectares.

LOCATION

The Winneway Settlement is located 100 kilometres east of Ville Marie, Timiskaming, on the south shore of the Winneway river, near lake Simard.

LAND TITLE HISTORY

May 25, 1959

Provincial Letters Patent 6529 - The Government of Québec authorizes to sell to the *Missionary Oblates of Mary Immaculate Corporation* the north half of lot 50, the north half of lot 51 of Range 8, as well as a part of lots 46 and 47 of Range 9, all in the township of Devlin. The area indicated is 116 acres.

November 4, 1959

Provincial Order in Council 1269 - The Government of Québec authorizes the signing of a lease between the *Missionary Oblates of Mary Immaculate Corporation* and the Government of Canada.

June 1, 1960 - Registration Number 1119-5

A 10 year lease is awarded to the Government of Canada by the *Missionary Oblates of Mary Immaculate Corporation* for lots 50 (part), 51 (part) of Range 8, as well as lot 46 of Range 9, township of Devlin. The area indicated is 91 acres (36.8 hectares).

June 1, 1970 - Registration Number 1119-5

Renewal of the 1960 lease for a further 10 year term.



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CHRONOLOGY OF BOUNDARY SURVEYS

- 1) **1962**: survey of lot 46 of Range 9 and of a part of lots 50 and 51 of Range 8, township of Devlin, by Robert Pelchat;
- 2) **1974**: resurvey of the outer boundaries of lot 50, Range 8, and subdivision of parcels on lot 50 of Range 8 and lot 46 of Range 9, by Louis-Philippe Deblois.
