The Association of Canada Lands Surveyors (ACLS) FORRI Task Force reviewed the Revised Policy Intention PDF document in English dated May 2018 available at http://www.nrcan.gc.ca/sites/www.nrcan.gc.ca/files/energy/energy-resources/Revised%20Policy%20Intention_EN_May%202018.pdf.

At the same time, all the other submissions were reviewed to further help the ACLS - FORRI Task Force to appreciate what other stakeholders had contributed, as well as to ensure the ACLS - FORRI Task Force had made its best efforts to listen to those stakeholders.

In the attached table the relevant section, paragraph and bullet are provided, along with a column for Comments / Suggestions, and another column for Background / Justification. We have tried to make the latter to be as succinct as possible. The ACLS - FORRI Task Force can provide further details on any particular background or justification comment should that be required.

To ease the identification of any suggested wording changes, in the Comments / Suggestion column these changes have been written in italic font and highlighted in yellow. This was realized as the easiest way FORRI could readily see any changes.

The ACLS is the national licensing body for professionals surveying on Canada Lands which is composed of the three Canadian Territories, the Federal Parks, Indigenous Reserves, and under the surface of Canada's oceans. The exclusive title attributed to these professionals is that of Canada Lands Surveyor (CLS).
